Registration: Based on the Rules regarding Competition organization issued by JJRS on March 1st 2017. The preliminary registration of competitors and referees should be sent 15 days before the competition. In accordance with this, the registration should be completed:

Preliminary registration until 04.10.2019, 12:00h

Final registration until 09.10.2019, 12:00h

Competition fee:

According to the JJRS rulebook for international tournaments:

- ju-jitsu fighting system (competitor): 30 KM (15 euro)
- duo-system (couple): 30 KM (15 euro)
- Ne-Waza (competitor): 30 KM (15 euro)
- Technique demonstration : 30KM (15 euro)

	14:00	The continuation of the competition, final matches , medal and diplomas award ceremonies (for the completed categories).

NOTE: The organizer reserves the right to adjust the plan of activities if needed. The potential new plan of activities will be announced after the final registrations, before the start of competition.

Referees:

The participating clubs are obliged to register at least one referee with an appropriate/valid licence(National or higher).The referees are registered using a registration template, together with competitors and team leaders, and it is sent to the e-mail of techical competition organizer: blazicdanijel@yahoo.com.

The clubs which do not have a referee are obliged to pay "referees fee" of 150 KM.

(This rule applies only to the clubs coming from JJSRS)

The president of the Referee Comission will select the referees eight days before the start of competition (Act 12. Of Competition Organization Rulebook), and he will notify the clubs. The referee list will be posted on the JJSRS website, together with the competition draw. The competition organizer will provide daily payments for the competition officials in accordance with JJSRS rules.

Team leaders and coaches:

The club representatives included in the competition registration form (coaches and team leaders) will be issued two accreditations for team leaders, after the team registration and competition fee payment.

Entrance to the competitor space during the competition will be

allowed only for the “called” competitors for next fight, (in gi) and for the team leaders (in sport equipment–tracksuit and sneakers)

Other information:

1. Only the competitors who fulfill the terms issued by the The JJSRS Competition Rulebook and the Competition Organization Rulebook will be allowed to compete.
 2. The team leaders are obliged to provide the evidence about an insurance policy, and medical evidence not older than 6 months for every competitor. (Acts 2. And 17. Of the JJSRS Competition Rulebok).
 3. The number of registered competitors per club in one category is not limited. A competitor can take part in fighting system, duo and ne-waza, but the organizer shall not arrange the timetable matches for the competitor.
 4. **A competitor can be registered only in his weight class or a weight/age class above him/her. The same competitor cannot be registered for two classes in the same age group.(Act 5. Of The Competition Organization Rulebook).**
 5. **Registration change is not possible after the final registration. (Act 5. Of Competition Organizing Rulebook).**
 6. The competition organizer does not carry any responsibility regarded to injury, loss or damage to personal belongings of a competitor and clubs, which may potentially occur while participating or travelling.
 7. The clubs are obliged to provide the necessary protection gear for their competitors (Act 19. Of The Competition Rulebook).
 8. The draw will be held by the IT Comission of JJSRS. The draw will be posted on the website of JJSRS by October 11., 2019. And there will be no additional changes (Act 15. Of the Competition Rulebook).
 9. Technical Organizer of tiurnament will provide food for referees, team leaders and officials.
 10. The team leaders are obliged to follow the plan of activities, and tp make sure that the competitors are ready for their matches in time.

- Children (U12) perform three self-defense techniques each (chosen by the competitor) from "A" and "B" Series of JJIF.
- Children (U14) and Children (U16) perform three self-defense techniques (main referee chooses the attacks) from Series "A" and "B" of JJIF.
- Aspirants (U18), Juniors (U21) and Seniors perform three Series, of JJIF list.
- DEMONSTRATION OF TECHNIQUES JJSRS

Based on Act 22. Of Competition Rulebook JJSRS Competition Commission JJSRS determines age categories of competitors in technique demonstration for 2019.:

Children (U10) 2010, 2012 Male and Female,
