## Right to participate and categories

The registration can possible in two different place on SportData to the EC and BpO. Athletes must be presented and registrated by their national federation to the European Cup or/and by their club or national federation to the Budapest Open.

All competitors must have the **legal passport of the nation they represent in the championship** and sports passport of their representative nation. Medical certificate, insurance, gender control and the like are the responsibility of the national federation/club registering the athletes.

According the new JJIF Organistions and Sporting Code 3.2.2: **max 4 persons** per category, per contry are allowed. After cloasure of the subscription time of event NO REFUND will be given.

Controll of entries and issuing is accreditation cards will take place at the Sporthall on Friday, 3.th of April 2020, during registration. At least one team official must attend in time to confirm the presence of all athletes and officials. The team official must be able to show all official documents and passports os all team members (copie are accepted).

An accreditation card shall be issued to all competitors, officials and crew members and should be carried at all times.

## Ju-jitsu gi and protectors

All competitors must have and use judogi according with the JJIF rules for official competitions. (white gi for all competition systems)

All competitors must have „back number” which can order from the Ju sport.

Soft hand and foot protector in proper color; mouthpiece and jockstrap are strongly recommended; chest protector for female competitors are strongly recommended.

## Liability

Neither the organizers is the event, or the National Federation (or any officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to any property arising out of participations and travelling in connection with this championship.



Coaches and team leaders are responsible to make sure that all competitors are physically fit, prepared and capable to cope with the championship.

## Advertizing

Please observe the regulations of the JJEU/JJIF as far as advertizing on judogi is concered.

## Referees

Each country should provide minimum 1 referee for up to 10 participants, 2 for up to 20 participants and 3 for 21 or more participants.

ONLY ON THE EUROPA CUP, a fee of 800 € per referee will be requested for not having the right number of referees and it will be collected by the organizer on the spot (conditioned for participation before the draw)

With the penalty fee, the JJEU have the possibility to invite extra referees from NF's, if necessary.

For the Budapest Open, the referees with National licences or higher are kindly invited to attend.

Countries registering referees for all days will be charged a double penalty, if their referees leave before the end of competition or do not referee at all on the last day.

## Dress Code

Coaches accompanying the athletes to the tatami will wear the national team track suit with sports shoes (closed). For the finals, formal clothes (with jacket) are recommended.

Athletes on the podium will wear the white competition gi, without any additional materials on their persons (flag, religious symbols, bottles of water, slippers etc.), according GAISF guidelines.
